Dear Patient:

We are pleased that you will be coming to the Neuro-Ophthalmology unit for an evaluation. Our unit is located in Building B on the Emory University Hospital campus, at the Emory Eye Center. We would like to share some information so you will know what to expect.

Your exam will include a detailed medical history and an eye exam with dilation of pupils. Since you will be dilated, you may want to come to your appointment with someone who can drive you home. During the first part of your visit you will be seen by an ophthalmic technician or a resident ophthalmologist and/or graduate ophthalmologist with ongoing neuro-ophthalmology training. Based upon that portion of the exam, additional tests may be ordered. You also will receive an exam by your scheduled neuro-ophthalmology specialist and be given ample time to discuss your problem and get answers to any questions you may have.

Your examination could require about 4 hours of your time. However, your stay could be prolonged if extra tests or treatments are required. We will do everything possible to see you at your scheduled appointment time, but please keep in mind that Emory is a referral center for difficult and complicated problems. Oftentimes, we are called upon to see complex cases on an emergency basis, which might make it difficult for us to maintain a tight schedule through the day. We ask for your patience if emergencies or unexpected complex cases put us behind schedule.

When you come for your appointment, please bring any records or letters from previous eye or neurologic exams performed outside the Emory system, and your glasses. It is important to bring actual x-rays, CT scans or MRI scans that have been performed elsewhere, not just the written reports of the results. You can request a copy of the scans on a CD from the radiology office where the test was done. If you have noticed any changes in your eyes or eyelids, please bring some old photographs taken before the changes occurred.

If you are unable to keep your appointment, please call 404-778-2020 as soon as possible so your appointment can be rescheduled. Please know that if you miss your appointment, we might not be able to reschedule it in a timely fashion. Thank you for your cooperation. We look forward to seeing you soon.

Emory Eye Center - Information for Our Patients

Location

The Emory Eye Center is located in Emory Clinic, Building B. This is a six-story building across the street from Emory University Hospital at the following address:

We are on the 1st, 3rd, 4th and 5th floors of this building. The location of your specific provider can be found on the Faculty and Providers' sheet.

Parking

Valet parking is available in the front Building A or you may self-park in the Lowergate deck behind Building B. All parking is paid parking. Public transportation is also convenient with a MARTA bus stop in front of the building.

Directions to The Emory Clinic, Building B

Traveling Interstate 85 North

Take I-85 North to N. Druid Hills Rd. Stay to the right of the exit, as it will split. Turn right at N. Druid Hills Rd. and stay on N. Druid Hills until you get to Briarcliff Rd. Turn right at Briarcliff Rd. Stay on Briarcliff until you get to Clifton Rd. Turn left on Clifton Rd. Stay on Clifton Rd. until you see Emory University Hospital on your right. Go under the pedestrian bridge and take an immediate left at the traffic light onto Lowergate Drive. Our building is on your right, between the new hospital tower and the Lowergate parking deck. Turn left at the first driveway for valet parking or continue under the pedestrian bridge and merge right for the patient parking deck (Lowergate).

Traveling Interstate 85 South

Take I-85 South to Clairmont Rd. Turn left onto Clairmont and follow it approximately 4 miles to North Decatur Rd. Turn right onto North Decatur Rd. Take North Decatur Road to Clifton Rd. and turn right onto Clifton Rd. Go to the second traffic light and turn right onto Lowergate Drive. Our building is on your right, between the new hospital tower and the Lowergate parking deck. Turn left at the first driveway for valet parking or continue under the pedestrian bridge and merge right for the patient parking deck (Lowergate).

From Interstate 20 East

Take exit 60B (Moreland Ave. N.). Turn right on Moreland and follow it approximately 3 miles. Moreland will change to Briarcliff Rd. once it crosses Ponce De Leon. Continue straight on Briarcliff approximately 2 miles to the traffic light at N. Decatur Rd. Turn right and follow N.

Decatur Rd. to the traffic light at the Clifton Rd. intersection. Turn left onto Clifton Rd. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Lowergate Dr. Our building is on your right, between the new hospital tower and the Lowergate parking deck. Take the first left for valet parking or continue under the pedestrian bridge and merge right for the patient parking deck (Lowergate).

From Interstate 75 North or South

Take exit 248-C, the Freedom Parkway exit. Cross Boulevard; continue on Freedom Parkway; veer left at the split; continue until it ends at Ponce de Leon Ave.; then turn right. Off Ponce, turn left on Briarcliff Road. Go approximately 2 miles to North Decatur Road. Turn right and follow North Decatur to the Clifton Road intersection. Turn left on Clifton Road. Take a right at the second traffic light on Lowergate Drive. Our building is on your right, between the new hospital tower and the Lowergate parking deck. Take the first left for valet parking or continue under the pedestrian bridge and merge right for the patient parking deck (Lowergate).

From Interstate 20 West

Take exit 60, Moreland Avenue N. Turn right on Moreland and follow it approximately 3 miles. Moreland will change to Briarcliff Rd. once it crosses Ponce De Leon Ave. Continue straight on Briarcliff approximately 2 miles to N. Decatur Rd. Turn right and follow N. Decatur to the traffic light at the Clifton Rd. intersection. Turn left onto Clifton Rd. Go to the second traffic light and turn right onto Lowergate Drive. Our building is on your right, between the new hospital tower and the Lowergate parking deck. Take the first left for valet parking or continue under the pedestrian bridge and merge right for the patient parking deck (Lowergate).

From Highway 78 West

Take Highway 78 until it ends. Continue on Scott Boulevard until you get to the intersection of North Decatur Road. It is a 6-road intersection. Turn right onto North Decatur Road. Continue down North Decatur Road past the Publix Supermarket on your left, and cross Clairmont Road. Stay on North Decatur until you reach the next large intersection, Clifton Road. Turn right onto Clifton Rd. Go to the second traffic light and turn right onto Lowergate Drive. Our building is on your right, between the new hospital tower and the Lowergate parking deck. Turn left at the first driveway for valet parking or continue under the pedestrian bridge and merge right for the patient parking deck (Lowergate).

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION: MARTA

Atlanta's mass transit system is MARTA (Metro Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority). MARTA operates a coordinated system of bus and train lines for access to all of Atlanta. Exact change (\$2.50) or tokens are required. Fare can be purchased at all MARTA rail stations or online (www.martaguide.com). Cash is only accepted on buses, but drivers cannot make change.

The Emory campus is accessible from the Lindbergh station and the Inman Park station on the #6-Emory bus or from the Midtown station and the Avondale station on the #36-North Decatur bus.
